

### **Policy on Compensation for DE Course Development**

In recognition of the fact that preparation of materials in order to deliver a distance education course online is costly in terms of faculty time the College will pay faculty teaching a course entirely online as needed to support a college distance ed program \$2500 in salary or faculty development funds the first time the course is taught. If the course is assigned to a different faculty member who is teaching an online course for the first time, that person will also receive \$2500. If it becomes necessary to substantially revise the course (for example, because the textbook has changed) or if the course is assigned to a faculty member who has previously taught an online course the course development compensation will be \$1000.

The College (through the Dean's Office) will continue to supply 50% of the funding for ITAL courses.

Implementation of this policy is contingent on the availability of funding.
